


NEEDLES

- 1 pair 3¾mm (no 9) (US 5) needles
- 3¾mm (no 9) (US 5) circular needle at least 120 cm long
- 4mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle at least 120 cm long

TENSION

20 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over patterned st st using 4mm (US 6) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed bed runner/wrap is 75 cm (29½ in) by 199 cm (78½ in).

BED RUNNER/WRAP

- Using 3¾mm (US 5) circular needle and yarn B cast on 390 sts.
- Joining in and breaking off colours as required, work in g st as folls:
- Using yarn B, work 4 rows.
- Using yarn J, work 2 rows.
- Using yarn K, work 2 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
- Change to 4mm (US 6) circular needle.

Beg and ending rows as indicated and using the **intarsia** technique as described on the information page, cont in patt from chart, which is worked entirely in st st beg with a K row, as folls:

Row 1 (RS): Work all 211 sts of row 1 of chart, then work rem 179 sts as row 1 of chart from A to B.

Row 2: Work first 179 sts as row 2 of chart from B to A, then work all 211 sts of row 2 of chart.

These 2 rows set the sts.

Keeping sts correct as now set, cont in patt until all 198 rows of chart have been completed, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3¾mm (US 5) circular needle.

Break off contrasts.

Joining in and breaking off colours as required, now work in g st as folls:

Using yarn K, work 2 rows.

Using yarn J, work 2 rows.

Using yarn B, work 3 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Cast off knitwise (on **WS**).

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Side borders (both alike)

With RS facing, using 3¾mm (US 5) needles and yarn K, pick up and knit 149 sts evenly along row-end edge, between cast-on and cast-off edges.


Joining in and breaking off colours as required, work in g st as folls:

Using yarn K, work 1 row.

Using yarn J, work 2 rows.

Using yarn B, work 3 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Cast off knitwise (on **WS**).
